Sub: Accordance of clearance by Irrigation & Waterways Department on the proposals of regularisation of brick fields.

With a view to regularize existing brick fields that have come up on agricultural land after 01.09.2000 in different districts, the L & R Department has brought out regulatory, locational and operational guidelines vide their memorandum under reference-1. District Land & Land Reforms Officers have been declared as Ex-officio Environment officers for the purpose of grant or refusal of Consent-to-Establish (COE) and Consent-to-Operate (CoO) of the brick fields, having the matter examined at respective District Level Screening and Scrutiny Committee constituted by the Environment Department vide their notification no-EN/202/3C-01/2013 dated 01.01.13, subsequently modified vide their no-1004-EN/3C-01/2013 dated 22.04.15. Executive Engineers of Irrigation & Waterways Department are the members of the said District Level Screening and Scrutiny Committee for the districts within their territorial jurisdictions.

Since clearance of Irrigation & Waterways Department was made as a pre requisite for further processing of proposals of regularization of brick fields at District Level Screening and Scrutiny Committee, as per cl-3 of the memorandum under ref-1, this department brought out an order, referred at sl-2, declaring one Superintending Engineer of this department as nodal officer for each district to accord clearance on behalf of this department on such proposals, received from District Level Screening and Scrutiny Committee.

It has come to the notice of this department that separate consent from the Superintending Engineers are not required as the view of the Executive Engineers of this department in the respective district level committee is sufficient to further process the proposals of brick field regularization.

In view of above the undersigned is directed to inform that henceforth the views/consent of the Executive Engineers on the proposals of regularization of brick fields, placed in the respective District Level Screening and Scrutiny Committee, may be considered as the clearance/refusal of this department. The Executive Engineers will examine such proposals, received from the office of DL&LRO, as per guidelines set forth in the L&LR department, memorandum under reference -I and convey this consent/refusal to the DL & LRO for further examination at District Level Screening & Scrutiny Committee. However, the Executive Engineer will keep the Superintending Engineer concerned informed. Permission of Superintending Engineer concerned will however, be required if the proposed site falls within 200 metre from the river bank, major bridges and embankments as per clause 7 & 8 of the Regulatory guidelines.

A monthly statement of the processed cases of any month is to be sent to this department by each Executive Engineer by 10th of the succeeding month.
