Office Order

The causeway constructed by Bankura (I) Division across the river Darakeswar at village – Surpanagar, block- Onda, district Bankura in 2015-16, for providing a through fare for local inhabitants, has been damaged during the passage of high discharge in July-2016, rendering it unsuitable for plying of vehicles and even for movement of the pedestrians. It has been felt necessary to ascertain the reasons of such damage of a newly constructed structure and also identify deficiencies during design and also construction, if any.

In view of above, the undersigned is directed to inform that an Enquiry Committee is constituted with the following composition and terms of reference.

Terms of reference:-

- Collection and examination of relevant documents/data relating to decision, execution, and discharge passing down the river during critical period. Further subsoil investigation and testing of materials used in construction or suitable non destructive test on the completed components may be done in this connection, if found necessary.
- 2. Finding out probable causes of failure and identifying lapses, if any, which might have occurred during design or construction stage.
- 3. Suggesting suitable measures for systems improvement both for Planning and during execution Phases so that such incidents do not occur.
- 4. The committee will submit their report within 60 days from the date of issue of this order, to this department suggesting suitable measures for rehabilitation of structure, to serve the purpose for which it was constructed.

The Executive Engineer, Bankura (I) Division will arrange all the logistic support for the committee, to undertake site visit.
