Other concerned Superintending Engineers and Executive Engineers also remained present.

Agenda: Clearance of projects in conformity with Phase-II allocation under State Development scheme budget during the current financial year of 2018-19 for Core Sector and HPC allocation under RIDF-XXIV.

Secretary took the chair. Financial Advisor, Chief Engineer (West), Chief Engineer (South), Chief Engineer (South West), Chief Engineer (West) and other officers remained present.

The following were discussed:

7 (Seven) no. DPRs of schemes proposed under Core Sector of State Development Schemes budget at an aggregate cost of Rs. 17.05 crore and 2 (two) schemes at an aggregate cost of Rs. 25.80 crore under RIDF-XXIV were initially placed before the committee.

After a threadbare discussion the following decisions were taken:

1. Out of High Power Committee (HPC) allocation of Rs. 220.00 crore for RIDF-XXIV, schemes worth Rs. 203.14 crore have already been submitted to NABARD, and hence balance allocation available is Rs. 16.86 crore.
2. The DSC decided to accept inclusion of the two new schemes as detailed in Annexure-I at an aggregate cost of Rs. 25.80 crore under RIDF-XXIV in spite of the total cost exceeded the HPC allocation by Rs 8.94 crore.
3. In addition, 4 (Four) no. of schemes as per Annexure-II were cleared by the DSC at an aggregate estimated cost of Rs. 10.88 crore for inclusion under Core Sector of State Development Schemes budget.
4. The Chief Engineers certified that there is no duplication of proposal with any other sources of funding, and all the schemes have been selected by them on the basis of field requirements.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks.
