1. Separate sealed Tender in printed form are invited by the Executive Engineer, Cooch Behar Irrigation Division on behalf of the Governor of West Bengal, for the works as per list attached herewith, from eligible Bonafide outsiders/Manufacturer having credential of execution of similar nature of supply of value 30%(Thirty Percent) of the amount put to tender within the last 5(five) years.

2. a) Separate Tender should be submitted for each work, as per attached List, in sealed cover super scribing the name of the work on the envelope and addressed to the proper authority.
b) Submission of Tender by Post is not allowed.
3. The Tender documents and other relevant particulars (if any) may be seen by the intending Tenderers or by their duly authorized representative during office hours between 11.00 AM and 4 P.M. on every working day, till 08.09.2017 in the office of the Executive Engineer, Cooch Behar Irrigation Division.
4. a. Intending Tenderers should apply for Tender Papers in their respective Letter Heads enclosing self attested copies of the following documents, originals of which and other documents like Registered Partnership (for Partnership Firms) etc. are to be produced on demand, as well as during interview (if any).
i) Attested Xerox copies of certificates for, PAN and Professional Tax submitted and registration of GST will be verified from original at the time of prequalification. Attested photo copy of credential certificate should be submitted which will be verified with the original at the time of prequalification.
ii) Completion Certificate/ payment Certificate (s) for one single similar work worth at least 30% of the value of the work for which tender Paper is desired, executed within last 5 (five) years (to be determined from the actual year of completion, considering current financial year as year-I).

v) Declaration by the Applicant to the effect that there is no other applications for Tender Paper for work in this NIT in which he/she/ they/ has/ have common interests. Failure to produce any of the above documents may be considered good and sufficient reason for non- issuance of tender paper.

b. "Completion Certificates issued by Competent Authority will normally be considered as credential. Apart from credentials of works executed under Irrigation & Waterways Department, credentials of works executed under Public works & Public Works (Roads) Departments, Public Health Engineering Department, Sundarban Affairs Department & other State Government Departments, Zilla Parish ads, WBHIDCO, WBSEDCL, KMDA, KMW & SA, KMC, HRBC; Engineering Departments of Central Government and Organizations like Railways, KoPT; and Mackintosh Burn Ltd., Westinghouse Saxby Farmer Ltd. & Britannia Engineering Ltd. may also be considered. Completion certificates are to be countersigned by the Executive/Divisional Engineers of the respective State/Central Government Departments, or Officer of the equivalent rank, if those are issued by some other authority. Over and above the completion certificates, certificate from the competent authority regarding payment received so far for the work (even if the full payment might not have been received), supported by Bank Statement showing that the corresponding amount of payment has actually been deposited in the Bank, will have to be produced in the cases of works executed under Departments/ Organizations other than Irrigation & Waterways Department, failing which credentials may not be considered."

c. Mackintosh Burn Ltd., Britannia Engineering Ltd. and Westinghouse Saxby farmer Ltd. will enjoy 10% price preference for the purpose of evaluation of tenders, in terms of G.O. No. 1110(500)-F dated 10.02.06 of the Finance Department.

- d Any suppression/ misrepresentations of fact will automatically debar the applicant from participating in any Tender under the Division/ Circle for at least 3 (Three) years from the date of detection, in addition to such penal action as the Government may deem proper.
5. Intending Tenderer not satisfied with the decision of the Tender Paper Issuing Authority may prefer an appeal to the next superior officer. Concerned Chief Engineer will be the Appellate Authority for High Value Tenders. Necessary communication regarding his appeal to the Appellate Authority must be brought to the notice of such Authority within two working days after the date of issue of tender paper, and copy of such communication should also be submitted to the Tender Paper Issuing Authority within the same period, failing which no such appeal will be entertained.
 6. a) No Tender paper will be supplied by Post;
b. No tender paper will be issued on the date of opening of tenders after expiry of date and time mentioned in the Notice.
 7. Before submitting any Tender, the intending Tenderers should make themselves acquainted thoroughly with the local conditions prevailing, by actual inspection of the site and take into considerations all factors and difficulties likely to be involved in the execution of work in all respects including transportation of materials, communication facilities, climate conditions, nature of soil, availability of local labourers and market rate prevailing in the locality etc. as no claim whatsoever will be entertained on these accounts afterwards.
 8. Earnest and /or security money as noted in the list of works, in the form other than mentioned below, will not be accepted.
Mode of payment : Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) must be submitted in the form of Bank Draft (BD) / Bankers Cheque (BC) of any scheduled Bank of India in favour of Executive Engineer, Cooch Behar Irrigation Division Payable at Cooch Behar. Payment in any other form eg. NSC, KVP etc. will not be accepted.
 - b. No adjustment of any sort of above mentioned Earnest Money previously deposited for other works will be considered. Tender without the specified earnest money will be treated as informal.
 9. (a) The Tenderer should quote the rate both in figures and in words on the basis of percentage above/ below or At Par the Schedule of Rates attached with the Tender Form and also in the space provided in the Tender Form;
b. Any tender containing over writing is liable to be rejected;
c. All corrections are to be attested under the dated signature of the Tenderer.
 10. When a Tenderer signs his Tender in an Indian Language, the total amount tendered should also be written in the same language. In the case of illiterate Tenderer, the rates tendered should be attested by an witness.
 11. The Tenderer who will sign on behalf of Company or Firm, must produce the registered documents (within 3 days from the date of opening the tender) in support of his competency to enter into an Agreement on behalf of the Company or the Firm under the Indian Partnership Act, failing which the Tender will not be considered and the deposited Earnest will be forfeited.
 12. Any letter or other instrument submitted separately in modification of the sealed tender may not be entertained.
 13. The Tenderer should submit a statement at the time of submission of his tender showing the Technical Staff to be maintained for the work, with their technical qualifications, failing which the tender may be liable to rejection.
 14. Conditional Tender, which does not fulfill any of the above conditions, and is incomplete in any respect, is liable to summary rejection.
 15. GST (CGST, SGST, IGST), Sales Tax, Royalty, Building Working Cess and all other statutory Levy/ Cess etc. will have to be borne by the Contractor (he will have to produce necessary documentary evidence of his having done so at the time of receiving the final payment for the work).
 16. The Tender Accepting Authority does not bind himself to accept the lowest tender and reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders received, without, assigning any reason whatsoever to the intending Tenderers and also reserves the right to distribute the work amongst more than one Tenderers.
 17. The Tenderer will have to, if so desired by the Tender Accepting Authority, submit his analysis to justify the rate quoted by him.
 18. The Tenders will be opened, as specified in the list of works, in presence of the participating Tenderers or their duly authorized representatives, who may be present at the time of opening and who may also put their signatures in the Tender Opening Register.
 19. The successful Tenderer will have to execute the duplicate/ triplicate/ quadruplicate copies of his tender which will have to be obtained by additional cash payment in the office of the Executive Engineer, Cooch Behar Irrigation Division, within 7 (Seven) days from the date of receipt of the intimation of acceptance of his tender failing which the Earnest Money shall forthwith stand forfeited in favour of the Government and the communication of acceptance of the tender shall automatically stand cancelled.

20. If any Tenderer withdraws his tender before its acceptance or refuses/ fails to convert it into a contract within a reasonable time, without giving any satisfactory explanation for such withdrawal/refusal/failure, he shall be disqualified for submitting any Tender in this Division/ Circle for a minimum period of one year and his case will be referred to the Government for order as to what further action will be taken against him.
21. The successful Tenderer will have to abide by the provisions of the West Bengal Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Rules 1972 and such other Acts as may be applicable, as will be in force from time to time.
22. Materials such as Cement, M.S. Rod, R.C.C. Hume Pipes, M.S. Sheet Piles, etc. if available in stock will be issued by the Department to the Contractor for the work as per Issue Rate fixed by the Engineer- in - Charge. Site of issue of materials as mentored in the list materials to be supplied Departmentally to the Contractor is furnished with the tender documents for the work. Any other materials not listed therein, if supplied by the Department, the issue Rate for such material will be fixed by the Engineer- in -Charge.
23. Hire charges for Tools & Plants Machinery, if issued Departmentally, will be recovered from the Contractor at such rates as will be fixed by the Engineer- in charge. The period of hire charges of all Tools & Plants Machinery issued from the Government godown will be counted from the date of their issuance from the Godown and up to the date of return into the same godown and the hire charges will be recovered from the Contractor accordingly. All Tools & Plants Machinery issued to the Contractor must be returned in good condition. In the case of any damage, the cost of repair to such damage or replacement will be recovered from Contractor.
24. In the following cases a tender may be declared informal and unacceptable.
- (a) Correction, alterations, additions, etc. if not attested by the Tenderer,
 - (b) Bank Draft (BD) / Bankers Cheque (BC) of Scheduled Banks guaranteed by the Reserve Bank of India not deposited in favour of the Executive Engineer, Cooch Behar Irrigation Division, Cooch Behar.
 - (c) If the Tender Form is not properly filled in respect of the general description of the work, Estimated Cost, Rate of deduction of Security Deposit, etc. in page-2 and other pages as are required to be filled in.
 - (d) If the specified pages of the Tender Document are not signed by the Tenderer;
 - (e) If the tender is not submitted in a Cover properly sealed and the name of the works is not indicated in the cover.
25. For the return of the Earnest Money of the unsuccessful Tenderer(s), he/ they is/ are to apply for the same to the Executive Engineer, Cooch Behar Irrigation Division, giving the reference to the work, N.I.T. No., date of tender, amount and mode of Earnest Money deposited – all in a complete form. The Earnest Money of all Tenderers other than the lowest Tenderer in each case, may be refunded, after acceptance of the rate in the comparative statement, as early as possible.
26. To verify the competency, capacity and financial stability of the Intending Tenderer(s) the Tender Paper Issuing Authority may demand production of any necessary document (s) as it may deem necessary.
27. The payment of R/A as well as any work will be made according to the availability of fund and no claim due to delay in payment will be entertained. Final Bill for
28. As per G.O. No. 1627 (8)/1A dated 26th November 2001 of Irrigation & Waterways Department, Government of West Bengal, Clause 25 of Tender Form No. 2911 stands deleted in respect of contract of value less than Rs. 100.00 Lakh.
29. Normally, Tender Paper for not more than one work in any one NIT will be issued to an applicant, who may indicate the SL. Nos. of the work in the order of priority. However, depending on response to various serials in the NIT, Tender Paper Issuing Authority may issue Tender Paper for any serial even though it may not be preferred by the applicant.

Categorization of Works :

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| 1. Earthwork | : Earthwork in excavation / filling for embankment canal, drainage channels executed under Irrigation & Waterways Department. |
| 2. Protection Works | : All kinds of river / channel bank / embankment protection works (with boulder, CC blocks, revetment works, sauses, brick blocks, dry brick pitching, etc.). |
| 3. Lining Work | : All kinds of water face lining / brick block pitching / dry brick pitching, in irrigation canal / drainage channel, etc. |
| 4. Hydraulic Structures | : Aqueducts, Regulators, Syphons, Bridges across Waterways, Sluices, Dams, Barrages, etc. |
| 5. M.S. Structural Works etc. | : Gates of all kinds, electrical installations, pumps and allied machinery. |

The above list is only indicative and not exhaustive.

30. Application for Issue of Tender Form:-
i) The application of the intending tenderer is to be addressed to the Executive Engineer, Cooch Behar Irrigation Division and to be submitted on or before the last date of application as stated. The intending tenderers should indicate in their application as to where from they intend to purchase the tender form.
31. Issuance of Tender Form:-
i) Issue of Tender form will rest with the Executive Engineer, Cooch Behar Irrigation Division who does not bind himself to issue tender form, reject any or all the applications for tender form without assigning any reason. He also reserves the rights to offer any serial of work in the list other than that specifically prayed for by the applicant. In this context on any discrepancy, the decision of the Superintending Engineer, North East Irrigation Circle-I shall be final and binding.
32. Purchase of Tender Form:-
i) Tender Forms may be purchased from the Office to the Undersigned.
33. Dropping of Tenders:-
i) Tenders in sealed covers may be dropped in the Tender Box in the office to the undersigned.
The name of the work with NIT No., SL. No. and name of the Tenderer should clearly be written on the sealed covers.
34. Opening of Tender:-
i) The tenders will be opened by the Executive Engineer, Cooch Behar Irrigation Division, Cooch Behar in his office at schedule time.
35. Acceptance of Tender:-
i) Acceptance of the tender will rest with the Executive Engineer, Cooch Behar Irrigation Division, who does not bind himself to accept the lowest tender and he reserves the right to reject any or all tenders received without assigning any reason and to distribute the work between more than one tenderer and issue work order in part.
36. (a) Successful Tenderers for supply works will have to deposit a further sum as earnest money which will constitute 10 % (Ten percent) of the tendered value, which added to the earnest money already deposited by the tenderers along with the tender and the original Challan thereof should be submitted together with the duplicate copy of the tender.
(b) In the event of further sum being not deposited within the stipulated date the previously deposited earnest money is liable to be forfeited & be deposited in favour of the Govt. of West Bengal and the letter of approval of the tender will automatically be considered as cancelled.
(c) Successful Tenderer shall have to deposit an additional sum which together with the 2 (Two) percent of the earnest money, will amount to 2 (Two) percent of the cost as per tendered rates of the works for which, the tender is to be accepted, within seven days of the receipt of an intimation of approval for acceptance from the Executive Engineer Cooch Behar Irrigation Division, Cooch Behar. Failing to deposit of this additional sum within the period specified above, the earnest money shall forthwith stand forfeited to Government and the letter of approval of the tender will be considered as automatically cancelled.
37. (a) GST (CGST, SGST, IGST), Royalty, Building & other Construction Workers' Cess and all other statutory Levy/Cess etc. will have to be borne by the Contractor (he/she will have to produce necessary documentary evidence of his having done so at the time of receiving the final payment for the work).
(b) Deduction of Income Tax @ as per rule from the sum paid to the contractors in each bill will be made as per Finance Deptt.
(c) Deduction of Cess payable @1% of the cost of construction works shall be deducted from the gross bill value of the Contractors for all sorts of works excluding supply of materials as per Departments Memo No. 853-I Dated 01-02-06 and Labour Department's Notification No. 1182-IR Dated 20-09-05, Govt. of West Bengal.
(d) In view of introduction of GST with effect from 01.7.2017, all the bidders intending to participate in this tender should offer their quoted rates inclusive of GST applicable for entire composite works/Procurement of goods & services, labour intensive component contained in the BOQ. Income Tax, Royalty, GST (CGST, SGST, IGST), Construction Workers' Welfare Cess, Labour Insurances and similar other statutory levy / cess will have to be borne by the contractor/bidder and his/her quoted rate should be quoted accordingly after considering all these charges, and no separate payment towards any of the statutory taxes shall be made by the implementing authority.
